Tuesday, January 4 COVID-19 Regional Update: Wood Buffalo Region**

We have transitioned the bulletin cadence to an as-needed basis when new information related to our response to COVID-19 dictates.

Information in today's bulletin:

Responding to Omicron: Omicron infections have spiked across our locations, and the following adjustments to our preventive measures have been made to keep our workforce and sites healthy and safe:

The mandatory rapid antigen screening program for individuals who are unvaccinated or partially vaccinated has now transitioned to screening **every 48 hours**.

Airport screening prior to boarding Suncor charter flights has also resumed for our Fly-in/Fly-out workforce.

N95 masks are now recommended and available to individuals coming to sites to physically support operations.

COVID-19 vaccinations, including booster shots, continue to be encouraged. Mobile vaccine clinics are being made available in the coming weeks at select operating locations. See next section for details.

Mandatory work-from-home measures continue to be in place for most Suncor locations. If you are not required to have a physical presence at your work location, please continue working from home.

As a reminder, all other existing protocols remain in place and only those needed to physically support critical operations should be accessing our sites. Anyone experiencing symptoms should stay home and contact their leader as well as Health & Wellness even if they have screened negative for COVID-19.

Mobile vaccination clinic returns:

The mobile vaccination clinic will return at the following dates and locations:

Syncrude – January 5, 13 & 15

Base Plant, Main Admin – January 6 & 7

Base Plant, Steepbank Mine Complex – January 12 & 14

Fort Hills – January 8 & 9

Firebag – January 10, 11, 18 & 19

MacKay River – January 11 & 19

*We're currently working on additional vaccination clinic dates for some locations.

First, second and third doses of Moderna and Pfizer vaccines will be available to all on-site employees and contractors on a first-come, first-served basis. This includes individuals who reside out of province.

Flu shots will also be available and can be received at the same time as a COVID-19 vaccine.

Anyone wishing to receive a vaccine should bring the following with them to the mobile clinic: Health card, Photo ID, and Previous COVID-19 vaccination records
